1. Cookie Policy

1.1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device (computer, tablet, smartphone) when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work efficiently and to provide information to the owners of the website.

1.2. Our Cookie Policy

At Prometheon, we value your privacy. We limit the use of cookies to what is necessary for a well-functioning website and clear statistics. We do **not** use advertising or remarketing cookies, but we do use **Google Analytics** to measure and improve the use of our website.

Privacy-first approach

Prometheon follows a **privacy-first** approach. This means:

- **No advertising or remarketing cookies**
- **Limited use of tracking:** only for web statistics via Google Analytics
- **No user profiling for marketing purposes**
- **Privacy-friendly settings for analytics (IP anonymization, limited retention periods where possible)**
- **Minimal data processing**

2. Types of cookies we use

2.1. Strictly necessary cookies

These are cookies that are essential for the functioning of our website. Without these cookies, certain functions cannot work. These cookies:

- Remember your session while you navigate through the website
- Provide security features
- Remember form data during a session

2.2. Functional cookies (if applicable)

Functional cookies remember your preferences and make the website more user-friendly. For example:

- Language preferences
- Display settings
- Previously entered form data

Note

Currently, our website makes minimal use of functional cookies. If this changes, we will update this cookie policy and inform you.

3. Third-party cookies

3.1. Analytical cookies (Google Analytics)

We use **Google Analytics** to gain insight into the use of our website so that we can improve it.

Google Analytics places cookies that collect information about:

- Visited pages and duration of the visit
- The type of device, operating system, and browser
- Anonymized IP addresses (IP anonymization activated)
- Click behavior and navigation patterns

We have configured Google Analytics to be as privacy-friendly as possible:

- IP anonymization is enabled
- No advertising features or remarketing lists are used
- Retention periods are limited where possible

The information collected by Google Analytics is stored by Google on servers that may be (partially) located outside the EU (for example, in the US). Google uses **Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs)** and additional safeguards to protect this transfer. You can find more information in Google's privacy policy and Google Analytics documentation.

In accordance with Article 11.7a of the Dutch Telecommunications Act (paragraph 3), these analytical cookies are placed without requiring prior consent via a cookie banner. Because these cookies are configured to be entirely privacy-friendly, they have no or only minimal impact on your private life. You can, of course, completely block Google Analytics via your browser settings or by using the **Google Analytics opt-out** options.

3.2. Social media & marketing

We do **not** place social media tracking pixels or marketing cookies from platforms such as:

- Facebook/Meta Pixel
- LinkedIn Insight Tag
- Google Ads remarketing
- Twitter/X tracking

If you share content via social media buttons on our website, these platforms may place their own cookies when you are logged into their services.

4. Your rights and choices

4.1. Managing cookie preferences

You always have control over cookies. You can:

Via your browser:

- Block or delete cookies
- Receive notifications when cookies are placed
- Allow or block specific websites

Popular browsers:

- Chrome: Settings > Privacy and security > Cookies
- Firefox: Options > Privacy & Security > Cookies
- Safari: Preferences > Privacy > Cookies
- Edge: Settings > Cookies and site permissions

4.2. Consequences of blocking cookies

If you block all cookies, this may affect the functionality of our website:

- Session information is lost on every page
- Forms may not work correctly
- Security features may be limited

4.3. Do Not Track (DNT)

We respect the **Do Not Track** setting in your browser. Because we only use limited analytics via Google Analytics and do not use advertising or remarketing cookies, DNT has a limited practical effect on your experience on our website.

5. Legal framework

5.1. GDPR

This cookie policy has been drawn up in accordance with:

- **GDPR** (General Data Protection Regulation)
- **Telecommunications Act** (specifically the exception for quality measurements in Article 11.7a Telecommunications Act, see also the official legislative amendment via <https://zoek.officielebekendmakingen.nl/kst-33902-3.html>)
- **ePrivacy Directive**
